**AD COUNCIL MEETING** — There will be a short Ad Council meeting at the front of the sanctuary following today’s service.

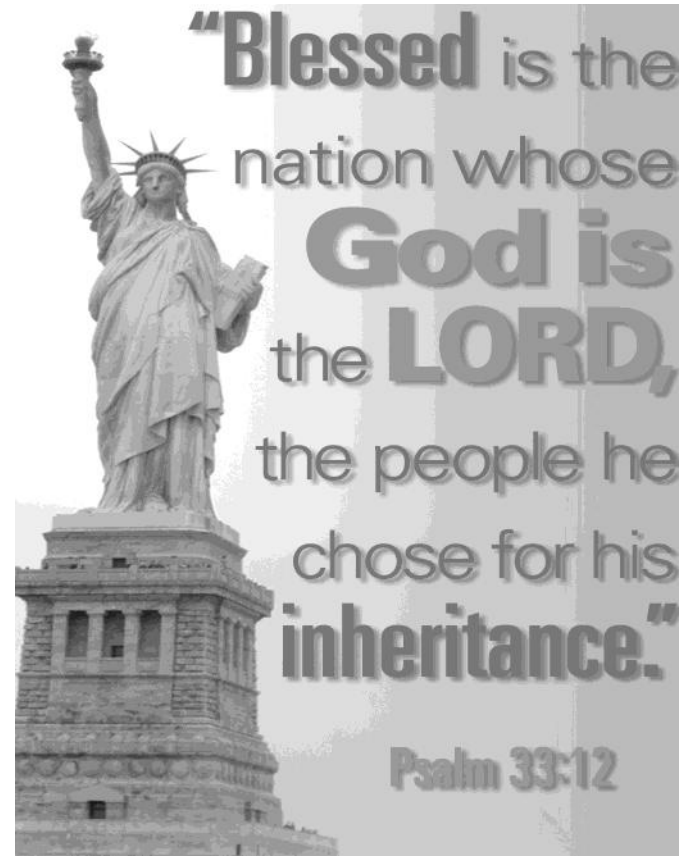
